Before allowing the students to appear at the final examination certain periodical class tests, assignments, and presentations are conducted each year at the class level to ensure a constant focus on studies. For appearing in the final examination's students are required to have attended at least 75% of the classes held. A departmental academic calendar is published and the dates are announced for the university examination for both major and regular undergraduate courses. Sessions of all courses are maintained strictly according to the academic calendar provided by the institution. All teachers from different departments are engaged in invigilation duty during examinations with strict invigilation. The answer books are evaluated by individual teachers and the final results are published within 14 days from the commencement of the examination.

The Department follows a transparent and frequent mode of assessing its students. *Sessional examination* is conducted as per course curriculum. *Internal class test* examinations are conducted after completion of each chapter provided in the syllabi. *Continuous evaluation* is made through group discussions, assignments, and class presentations. Personal guidance is also provided to the students whose performance is found to be poor in the internal examinations. The method of internal assessment helps the teachers to evaluate the students more appropriately. Due to this method, the interest of the student towards learning and attending the classes has been also increased.
